

Union Township Board of Supervisors  
Minutes/ Regular Meeting  
March 7, 2017

The regular monthly meeting of the Union Township Board of Supervisors was held on March 7, 2017 with all Supervisors present. Attendance sheet is also attached.

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM followed by the pledge to the flag.

Minutes of the previous meeting were called for and approved as read.

Public Comment: None

A review letter from Charles Axtman, PE on the Rt. 15 Mini Storage Final Land Development Plan was discussed.

The Board will meet with Tom Squires with Penn DOT as well as Frank and Barb Greak, on March 9, 2017 to discuss the signage and safety issue at the intersection of Park Road and State Route 304.

The Chairman brought to the attention of the Board that a drain pipe at the entrance of South Riverbreeze Ave. is broken out and needs replaced. Discussion was held on the location of the pipe and who has ownership and responsibility of it. The Board concurred that to maintain access for emergency responders, the Township should replace the pipe.

The road tour is scheduled for March 18, 2017 at 9:00 AM.

Two complaints were received by residents who are neighbors to 64 Clearfield Drive. The complainants both mentioned that their deed restrictions state that no farm animals are allowed in their development, however the residents of 64 Clearfield Drive have fowl running at large, causing a nuisance and defecating on neighboring porches. Atty. Lyons reviewed Animal Ordinance #96-1 and determined that the Ordinance does state "any animal" running at large and causing unsanitary conditions, meaning that they would be in violation of the Ordinance. Atty. Lyons said that it would be permissible to send a certified warning letter quoting the Ordinance. A motion was made by Nelson Poe, seconded by Tom Reitz and carried to approve sending a letter to Mr. and Mrs. Held of 64 Clearfield Drive.

The Chairman made contact with Casey Monagan at UGI to discuss the repair of Mulls Hollow Road. Mr. Monagan stated that when the entire pipeline project is completed, the road will then be fixed as per our agreement with them.

There will be a Green Light Go Program meeting at East Buffalo Twp. on April 7, 2017 that the Chairman and Secretary will be attending. Discussion will be on a possible joint application for the next round of funding for the program.

The 2017 Liquid Fuels allocation was received in the amount of \$89,084.27.

The Chairman and Tom Reitz attended a Penn DOT CSVT meeting on the issues that have come up regarding the re-routing of the southern section around the ash dam.
