

ORDINANCE NO. 81-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF UNION, UNION COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING SECTION 11 OF ORDINANCE NO. 80-1, ENACTED AUGUST 5, 1980, WHICH AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED THE TOWNSHIP OF UNION TO ENTER INTO A JOINT MUNICIPAL AGREEMENT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES WITH THE BOROUGH OF LEWISBURG, UNION COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, BY EXTENDING THE DURATION OF THE SAID AGREEMENT TO ONE YEAR FROM THE DATE THEREOF AND PROVIDING FOR THE AUTOMATIC RENEWAL OF THE SAME, UNLESS WRITTEN NOTICE OF TERMINATION IS GIVEN BY EITHER PARTY THIRTY DAYS PRIOR TO THE ANNUAL RENEWAL THEREOF.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Union, Union County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, in accordance with the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act of 1972, July 12, No. 180 [53 P.S. §481 et seq.], as follows:

Section 1. Section 11 of Ordinance No. 80-1, enacted August 5, 1980, is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"The said Agreement shall commence when enacted by this Ordinance and duly executed, and shall continue for a period of one year from the date thereof, and thereafter shall continue upon the same terms and conditions in force immediately prior to the expiration of the term thereof as are therein contained for a further period of one (1) year, and so on; provided, however, that either party thereto may terminate the said Agreement at the end of said term, or any renewal thereof, by giving the other party written notice thereof by personal service or certified mail, postage prepaid, return receipt requested at least thirty (30) days prior thereto."

Section 2. Except as amended by this Ordinance, all of the provisions of Ordinance No. 80-1, enacted August 5, 1980, shall remain in full force and effect.


Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after enactment hereof.
