

ORDINANCE NO. 87-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF UNION, UNION COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING FOR THE ERECTION AND MAINTENANCE OF STOP SIGNS AT THE CORNER OF EVERY DESIGNATED STREET INTERSECTION IN THE TOWNSHIP; AND REQUIRING ALL PERSONS OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE OR BICYCLE UPON THE STREETS OF THE TOWNSHIP TO STOP AT THE CORNER OF EVERY STREET INTERSECTION UPON WHICH IS INSTALLED A STOP SIGN.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Union, Union County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. Official traffic stop signs shall be erected and maintained at the corners of the following street intersections in the Township of Union:

1. Northwestern intersection of Reitz Avenue
(Township Route No. T-364) and Seven Kitchens Road.
2. Southwestern intersection of Mulls Hollow Road
(Township Route No. T-362) and Seven Kitchens Road.
3. Southwestern intersection of Trutt Road (Township Route No. T-358) and Felmev Road (Township Route No. T-331).
4. Northwestern intersection of Amish Road (Township Route No. T-356) and Felmev Road (Township Route No. T-331).
5. Southeastern intersection of Amish Road (Township Route No. T-356) and Felmev Road (Township Route No. T-331).
6. Southeastern intersection of Suplee Mill Road
(Township Route No. T-458) and Fruit Farm Road
(Township Route No. T-335).

Section 2. All persons operating a motor vehicle or bicycle upon the streets of the Township of Union shall come to a full stop at the corner of every street intersection upon which is installed an official traffic stop sign.


Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after enactment.






