

ORDINANCE NO. 97-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF UNION,
UNION COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING
THE SUPERVISORS' COMPENSATION; AND
REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 87-4, ENACTED
DECEMBER 28, 1987.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Union, Union County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. The Supervisors of the Township of Union shall receive annual compensation in the amount of One Thousand Eight Hundred (\$1,800.00) Dollars, payable monthly in equal installments of One Hundred Fifty (\$150.00) Dollars; provided, however, that such compensation shall be paid only to new or reelected Supervisors taking office following the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 87-4, enacted December 28, 1987, and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after enactment.
